INS1 Martin KerstenStefan Manegold (2011)Fellowship after 17 years of management duty

INS2 Lynda Hardman Arjen P. de Vries (2011) Transfer of skills from INS1 -> INS2

INS3 Robert van Liere moved to SEN (2011) Subcritical mass, lack of external funding

INS4 Harry Buhrman became PNA6 (2010) Logistic positioning closer to PNA-6 after move



Group evolution

INS1 Stefan Manegold

- Large group (15-20 fte)
- Healthy project portfolio and acquisition power
- Expanding into scientific database arena

INS2 Arjen P. de Vries

- Relatively small (6-9 fte)
- Healthy project portfolio
- Opportunity to expand using complementary expertise of Arnold Smeulders



Weaknesses

- INS1 very strong, internationally recognised
- INS2 broad mix of skills

- Imbalance in group size
- Imbalance in acquisition power
- Missing data analytics component



Opportunities

- Grow and develop multimedia search (back & frontend)
- Flagship projects and connections with scientists

Threats

- Availability of NL research funding after COMMIT
- By focussing, forget to atract new topics
